
> Alpha Bank stands by the side of our vulnerable fellow citizens for yet another Easter

The #ShowYourKidneys initiative is part of a broader effort to raise awareness in society on information, prevention and recognition of the risk factors associated with chronic kidney disease. Using Social Media as its main platform, this global movement encourages individuals, organised and non-organised groups to participate by posting photos with their fists placed near the location of the kidneys, showing this way the importance of our kidneys and supporting awareness efforts for Chronic Kidney Disease.

Through the partnership with Alpha Bank Cyprus, and Europa Donna Cyprus, the pillows of "The Pillow Positive Project", are offered free of charge to recovering women in Cyprus as a symbol of support and positive energy (June 2024).
